Call for Papers

The PhD Student Workshop is organised within the auspices of the **INTERNATIONAL INTERDISCIPLINARY CONFERENCE ON SOCIAL INNOVATIONS (SOCIN'2022)** at Mykolas Romeris University (Vilnius, Lithuania). The PhD Student Workshop is organised to foster cooperation between early career researchers and established academics and to enable early career researchers to present their research and to benefit from feedback and support. Also, the Workshop will facilitate interdisciplinary exchange of ideas as SOCIN is an interdisciplinary conference with multiple tracks within the social sciences.

To be eligible for the Workshop, a candidate must be a doctoral student enrolled at a recognised university. The participants at the PhD Student Workshop are encouraged to register for and attend the main SOCIN conference. The PhD student should be the sole author of the submission. The selection is on a rolling basis and early submission is strongly encouraged.

The candidates are required to initially submit an abstract (the title and up to 300 words abstract) of the research they intend to present at the Workshop. Then, selected candidates will be required to submit an up to 10 pages long outline of their research, including research question(s), methodology, and novelty. At the Workshop, the participants will have 5 minutes to present their research then followed by up to 20 minutes of discussion with selected academics whose expertise lies within the presented topic.

Workshop participants will not only receive certificate for participating in an international conference, will have the opportunity to discuss with experts, but also, taking into account valuable insights, will be able to improve their research and thus increase the probability of smooth publication of their research. These are just a few reasons why it is important for PhD students to participate in PhD Student Workshop of this year's International scientific conference on Social Innovations (SOCIN'22).
